

**SIDELETTER OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS, LOCALS 55A and 55B
(LOCAL 55)
AND
ALAMEDA COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT (ACFD)**


**PREMIUM CONDITION FOR
TEMPORARY AMBULANCE SERVICES**

April 29, 2022

The Alameda County Fire Department (“ACFD”) and the International Association of Firefighters Locals 55A and 55B (“Local 55”) agree to establish a temporary premium condition to compensate employees who provide ambulance services in accordance with, and during the term of, the Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) between ACFD and Falck Northern California Corporation (“Falck”). The premium condition shall be as follows:

Effective April 28, 2022, employees who are assigned to work a temporary assignment in a dual role of fire suppression and medical ambulance services or who work overtime shifts providing ambulance services, shall receive an additional five percent (5%) of the employee’s 56-hour rate base pay only for hours worked in the dual role of fire suppression and medical ambulance services temporary assignment and overtime shifts. This premium condition only applies to employees who provide ambulance services in accordance with the MOU between ACFD and Falck and shall sunset at the expiration date of the MOU between ACFD and Falck.


