

SEVERE NAUSEA

- **Routine Medical Care**
- **Indications:** Intractable vomiting or severe nausea
- **Contraindications:** Hypersensitivity to 5-HT₃ receptor antagonists (i.e. – dolasetron (Anzemet), granisetron (Kytril))
- **Note #1:** Consider other treatable causes
- **Note #2: Administering Zofran rapidly can cause syncope**
- **Note #3:** Consider Diphenhydramine (25mg) if patient exhibits s/s of allergic reaction
- **Note #4:** When Morphine is used for pain relief, Zofran may be co-administered
