

## SHOCK: HYPOVOLEMIC/CARDIOGENIC

- Routine Medical Care
- Shock - 2 or more of the following:
  - ➔ Pulse > 120/minute
  - ➔ BP < 90/systolic
  - ➔ Altered Mental Status
  - ➔ Pale, cool and/or diaphoretic skin signs
- Initiate early transport and treat en route, if appropriate.
- NOTE: A fluid bolus of up to 500 ml Normal Saline may be given to an adult patient in cardiogenic shock with clear lung sounds.
