

SEIZURE (# 7221)

- **Routine Medical Care**
- Spinal Immobilization, if trauma suspected.
- Diazepam or midazolam should not be given unless the patient is actively seizing - 3 or more seizures in ≤ 5 minutes or any seizure lasting > 5 minutes.
- **Note #1 Cooling Measures:** Loosen blankets and/or remove excessive clothing.
- **Note #2 Glucose paste:** may be administered if the patient: **1)** is a known diabetic; **2)** is able to hold head upright; **3)** has a gag reflex; and, **4)** can self-administer the medication.
- Protect the patient from further injury by padding or moving objects as necessary; do not forcibly restrain the patient.
