ISSUANCE OF NEW REGISTRATION PERMIT FOR CERTIFIED BLUE RECYCLING
Date of Notice: September 19, 2017

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 27, Section 21660.1(b) that Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Office of Solid/Medical Waste Management, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for CalRecycle has accepted the Registration Permit application package to operate a Medium Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Facility at Certified Blue Recycling. A new registration permit was issued as described below:

Description of Registration Permit Application: An application for a new registration permit to operate a Medium Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Facility for Certified Blue Recycling (CBR) was filed with CalRecycle on September 15, 2017. CBR is permitted to accept up to 174 tons per day of construction and demolition and inert (CDI) debris. The facility is located at 2075 Williams Street, San Leandro, California.

LEA Findings: The LEA accepted the application package as complete and correct on September 15, 2017, pursuant to 14 CCR, Chapter 5, Article 3, Section 18104.1. The Medium Volume CDI Debris Processing Facility is subject to the requirements of 14 CCR, Section 17383.5 and state minimum standards as set forth in 14 CCR, Division 7, Chapter 3.0, Section 17383 of Article 5.9, Article 6.2 and sections 17406.1, 17406.2 of Article 6.1 and 17414 of Article 6.3.

Appeals Process: Any appeal will be processed in accordance and pursuant to Public Resource Code sections 44307 and 44310 (PRC §44307). Appeals can only be made after the decision to issue or deny the permit has occurred.
