Subject: Amend the Military Time Bank Ordinance to Extend it Through June 30, 2018

Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

Adopt an ordinance amending the Military Time Bank ordinance to extend it through June 30, 2018 and expand the program to include Operation Freedom's Sentinel.

Discussion/Findings:

On October 30, 2001, your Board established a Military Time Bank to fund salary and benefit continuation for eligible employees ordered to active military service due to Operations Enduring Freedom and Noble Eagle. The Program was subsequently expanded to include Operation Iraqi Freedom. Operation Iraqi Freedom was completed in December 2011, but Operations Enduring Freedom and Noble Eagle remain in effect. Your Board has authorized extending the program without interruption, and has expanded the program to include Operation Freedom's Sentinel which began on January 1, 2015.

This amendment will implement these changes through June 30, 2018.

Funding:

There will be no increase in net County cost as a result of this action.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-2002-30,
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND IMPLEMENTING
A TIME BANK FOR MILITARY ABSENCES OF COUNTY EMPLOYEES
DURING OPERATIONS ENDURING FREEDOM, NOBLE EAGLE
AND OPERATION FREEDOM'S SENTINEL**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Section I, Subsection 2, of Ordinance number 0-2002-30 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. **Eligibility.** This program applies only to employees who, as members of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States or the National Guard or Naval Militia, are ordered to active military duty from County service due to Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Noble Eagle and Operation Freedom's Sentinel. This program does not apply to employees ordered to active military training, encampment, naval cruises, special exercises, or like activity for which the employee is entitled to a temporary military leave of absence pursuant to Section 395.01 of the California Military and Veterans Code. To be eligible for payments under this program, the recipient must first exhaust the 30 calendar days of salary or compensation to which he/she may be entitled pursuant to Section 395.02 of the Code as well as all accrued paid leave time, excluding sick leave but including vacation, compensating time off, in-lieu time, and floating holidays.

SECTION II

Section II, of Ordinance number 0-2002-30 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended as follows:

This Ordinance shall be void and of no further effect as of June 30, 2018.

SECTION III






