SUBJECT: ACCEPT THE FY 2019 OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLE GRANT

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION:

- A. Accept the 2019 California Department of Parks and Recreation, California Off Highway Motor Vehicle Motor Vehicle Division Cooperative Agreement for Off-Highway Motor Vehicles and Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Safety in the amount of \$25,137 for the period 11/1/20 - 10/31/21;
- B. Approve a Resolution of Support for the California OHMV Motor Vehicle Division grant for Off-Highway Motor Vehicles and Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Safety, as required by the California Department of Parks and Recreation, California OHMV Motor Vehicle Division;
- C. Authorize the Sheriff, by title, to apply for and execute the related grant application and agreements, upon approval as to form by County Counsel, and to submit executed copies to the Clerk of the Board for filing; and
- D. Authorize the Sheriff, or his designee, to sign quarterly reimbursement claims and submit annual performance reports to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, California OHMV Motor Vehicle Division.

DISCUSSION/ SUMMARY:

The California State Parks Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program provides for well managed off-highway vehicle recreation within the state of California. The Sheriff's Office will utilize grant funds to purchase equipment and pay for overtime to patrol and engage in off-highway vehicle enforcement. The Sheriff's Office has supplied mutual aid to supplement California State Police Forces in deterring crime, trespassing and unauthorized off-highway motor vehicle operation in unincorporated areas. The Sheriff's Office currently deploys personnel on a regular basis for rural patrol.


FINANCING:

No additional appropriation is required. Funding for this grant program is included in the Sheriff's Office FY2020-2021 approved budget. The costs associated with the off-highway motor vehicle program will be offset with funding from the 2019 California State Parks Grant Program. The match of \$9,085, will be provided by the personnel cost of the lead instructors at the Sheriff's Office Regional Training Center and supply costs for OHV helmet communication equipment. There will be no increase in net County cost as a result of your approval.

The acceptance and distribution of the 2019 California Department of Parks and Recreation Grant for the off-highway motor vehicle program meets the 10x goal pathways of **Crime Free County** in support of our shared vision of **Safe and Livable Communities**.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda, State of California, desires to receive state funding from the California State Parks, Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division Grant Project 2019/2020

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff, by title, is designated and authorized by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda to apply for the California State Parks, Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, and is designated and authorized to execute on behalf of the County of Alameda the Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof, upon review and approval of the County Counsel; and to accept grant funds in the amount of \$25,137.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Alameda agrees to provide matching funds in the amount \$9,085.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereafter shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and that this award is not subject to local hiring freezes.
