SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE AN INCREASE IN APPROPRIATIONS WITH OFFSETTING

REVENUE FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

Dear Board Members:

### RECOMMENDATION:

- A. Authorize an increase in appropriations for the District Attorney's Office in the total amount of \$305,232 for contract labor which will be fully offset with revenue from the District Attorney Trust Fund (code 84101); and
- B. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make the related budget adjustments as per the attached Financial Recommendation.

### SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The District Attorney's Office has funds in the District Attorney Trust account 84101. This increase in appropriations will be used to offset expenditures related to contracted labor associated with the onboarding of the new administration.

The increase in appropriations will be used to offset expenses incurred upon the new administration's arrival. In January 2023, the County Human Resources recommended utilizing a temporary employment firm, Tryfacta, Inc., to cover the staffing expenditures for new staff until they could be onboarded into the County system for a total amount of \$305,232.

The completion of the onboarding process can take 30 days or longer and the previous administration did not provide onboarding support. Without the use of the third-party vendor the newly elected District Attorney would not have been able to bring her staff with her upon entering the office. This cost may have been avoided had individuals been allowed to onboard at the end of the last administration. This request was declined by the previous District Attorney.

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Requests of this nature are not unprecedented. Last year funds were used for public outreach campaigns, computer equipment and peripherals and office furniture. These purchases qualify as permissible uses of unrestricted funds from trust.

## FINANCING:

The additional appropriations requested will be fully offset with funding currently held in the District Attorney's Office unrestricted trust fund (code 84101). There will be no increase in the Net County Cost in current or future years.

## VISION 2026 GOAL:

The Equitable Sharing Program meets the 10x goal pathway of <u>Crime Free County</u> in support of our shared vision of <u>Safe and Livable Communities</u> and <u>Thriving and Resilient Populations</u>.
