That your Board adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment modifying the salary structure and establishing salary administration criteria for a job classification in the Health Care Services Agency.

Discussion/Findings:

The Health Care Services Agency has requested to modify the salary structure for Job Code 5045EM, Director, Behavioral Health Care Services, from the current "flat" rate salary changed to a "deep" class salary range. This will allow the Department more flexibility when appointing incumbents to the position. This action does not result in any increase in compensation for the job classification.
