SUBJECT: AWARD A \$160,469 CONTRACT TO GOVDELIVERY, INC., FOR THREE YEARS OF SERVICE

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a sole source contract (**Procurement Contract #2669**) to provide automated email information to County residents for three years and authorize the Purchasing Agent to Approve and Issue a Purchase Order to GovDelivery, Inc. (Principal: Zach Stabenow) 380 Jackson Street, Suite 550, St. Paul, Minnesota). This contract is for three years beginning approximately June 15, 2008 and ending approximately June 14, 2011 for a total of \$160,469. The first year of this contract begins approximately June 15, 2008 and ends approximately June 14, 2009 for a total cost of \$70,137. By mutual agreement, this contract can be renewed two additional one-year terms of \$45,166 each.

DISCUSSION/FINDINGS:

Alameda County Information Technology currently does not have a method by which to notify County residents of updates to the County Website. In an effort to improve communication with residents by utilizing e-mail and text messages to deliver important alerts, announcements and updated information, the County needs an automated e-mail subscription management system that works with the County's existing website and content management system and is easy to manage.

Gov Delivery is the only company in the country that is offering this type of service. Visitors to the County Website can subscribe to the service asking they be informed when content they are interested in changes or becomes available. With GovDelivery, the County will be able to offer residents: 1) automatic e-mail notifications of County information; 2) personal profile of County e-mail subscriptions and reminders for County residents; 3) real-time distribution of specific information. In addition, it would also allow Alameda County to reach residents in the event of emergencies, or other ad hoc notification needs.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS:

Information Technology Department wishes to sole-source this purchase order inasmuch as GovDelivery, Inc. is the sole provider in the country that offers this service. GovDelivery specializes in a small niche servicing government agencies with a platform that allows for Digital Subscription Management. Currently there are ten counties, eight cities and fifty-one federal agencies in California that utilize this service. After posting bids for this service, the General Services Agency approved and authorized the GovDelivery, Inc which was found to be the only vendor that specializes in email subscriptions.

This is to document my finding that competitive bidding is not possible for E-mail Subscription Management services and technical support in the amount of \$70,137 for the Information Technology Department (ITD). Therefore, the Departmental Justification to Request a Waiver of County Competitive Bidding Requirement, copy attached, is approved.

In accordance with the County Administrative Code Section 4.12.010 entitled "Purchases to be by Competitive Quotation", all purchases of and contracts for materials, supplies, services, furnishings, equipment, livestock, and other personal property shall be based wherever possible on competitive quotations.

I have reviewed the attached Departmental Justification to Request a Waiver of County Competitive Bidding Requirement. I have determined the requested product and/or supplier cannot be substituted to satisfy the County's requirements. ITD needs to improve communication with the County residents by utilizing email and text messages to deliver important information. They need an automated e-mail system that works seamlessly with the County's existing website and content management system which is easy for department staff to manage. GovDelivery is the only company able to offer this type of service: 1) automatic e-mail notification of County information; 2) personal profile of County e-mail subscription and reminders; and 3) Real-time distribution of specific information. In addition, it would also allow the County to reach residents in the event of emergencies, or other ad hoc notification needs. The attached Advance Notice of Sole Source Procurement was posted on the County website for 10 business days. No response was received. Therefore, competitive quotations are not possible and the request is recommended for your approval. ITD is required to obtain Board approval for these goods and services which exceed \$25,000.

Executive Summary

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Situation

Alameda County (the “County”) wants to reduce costs and improve communication with residents by utilizing e-mail and text messages to deliver important alerts, announcements, and updated information. The County needs an automated e-mail subscription management system that works seamlessly with the County’s existing website and content management system and is easy for department staff to manage.

GovDelivery® Will Allow Alameda County to Improve Communication and Lower Costs

With GovDelivery, the County will offer residents:

- Automatic e-mail notifications of County information
- Personal profile of County e-mail subscriptions and reminders for County residents
- Real-time distribution of specific information

Every visitor to the website can build a “My Alameda County” profile of information they wish to receive automatically by e-mail.

County residents can stay informed of updates to news releases, emergency notifications, newsletters, employment opportunities, election results, meeting minutes & agendas, water quality reports, budget plans, annual reports, health alerts, volunteer opportunities, library events, road construction projects, recycling changes, Sheriff most wanted, crime alerts, economic development updates, tourism events, planning documents, bid notices, property tax updates, District updates and many other time sensitive announcements published to the County website.

The County will also be able to use GovDelivery’s “Questions” feature to collect valuable information from residents. The “Questions” feature allows the County the ability to target communications to groups based on how the people answered the questions such as by zip code or neighborhood.

Why should Alameda County use GovDelivery?

GovDelivery will allow Alameda County to provide quality service to the public while reducing paper distribution costs, minimizing inbound phone calls, and decreasing staff administration time.

GovDelivery manages all databases, mass e-mailing issues, security, and technology upgrades. In addition, GovDelivery can ensure utilization by watching the County’s web pages and automatically sending appropriate e-mails when relevant changes are made to website content.

Service Areas

GovDelivery, Inc. provides all the services that Alameda County will need to setup GovDelivery on its existing website. Little work is required of the County to get up and running with the system.

Setup Services

GovDelivery, Inc. works with Alameda County to identify content that the County wants to promote and distribute using e-mail subscriptions. GovDelivery's web administration tools allow the County easy access to the master database of all e-mail subscriptions. Alameda County has control of all information before it is posted online and can add, subtract, or change subscription options at anytime. GovDelivery recommends placement of HTML links within the Alameda County website that will enable users to move seamlessly from the County's website to e-mail subscription features.

Application Hosting Services

To minimize costs and increase convenience, GovDelivery, Inc. manages the GovDelivery system on highly secure central servers. Hosting and maintenance services include:

- Management of all user profiles and subscriptions
- Automated distribution of appropriate e-mails to the public
- Management of all mass e-mailing issues including management of bounced e-mails (i.e., permanently or temporarily invalid e-mail addresses) and deliverability rates (getting e-mail updates into the inboxes)
- Unlimited access and training to web-based tools to add or modify new e-mail subscription options and manage subscription lists
- Unlimited e-mail subscription options related to County information
- Detailed usage reports so Alameda County knows exactly how residents use personalized e-mail subscriptions
- Regular technology upgrades to the application
- Reliable customer service, training and account management

Setup Process

The setup process for GovDelivery has 3 main steps:

1. Identify e-mail subscription content for the County
2. Identify administrators of the County's e-mail subscription options
3. Place HTML links to GovDelivery features on the County website (one-time process)

Identify E-mail Subscription Content

GovDelivery, Inc. creates an initial draft of content that the County should consider offering by subscription and the County approves or modifies subscription categories, subcategories, and items.

Identify Administrators

Alameda County provides GovDelivery with the name and e-mail addresses of the administrators in charge of the content that the County wants residents to subscribe to by e-mail.

Place Links On Current Website

The last step of setup involves the placement of HTML links connecting the Alameda County website to GovDelivery functionality. After analyzing the current Alameda County website, GovDelivery will generate a plan suggesting the placement of links. Final HTML link set up takes approximately 2-3 hours of work by the County Web administrator.

GovDelivery, Inc. will perform the services described in this statement for the fees listed below. This quote is based on information provided by Alameda County and is subject to change if there is a substantive change in requirements.

Terms

The term for the Ongoing Monthly Services is 12-months, cancelable with 30 days of written notice at any time. If the County cancels before the end of the twelve month term, it will be liable only for the services used up to the point of cancellation. The term automatically renews for consecutive 12-month periods if no written notice is given.

Billing

The setup fee is due when the contract with GovDelivery, Inc. is signed, net 30 days. The GovDelivery system will be available for use by Alameda County within 3 business days of contract signing or receipt of a purchase order.

Monthly fees will be billed on or before the 5th day of every month. Monthly billing will begin with contract signing with any partial months being prorated. Monthly billing will continue in subsequent years so long as Alameda County offers links to GovDelivery functionality from its website. Monthly fees can also be billed on an annual basis.

Privacy & Ownership of Information

All content and associated information provided by Alameda County and user information (e.g., e-mail addresses) from Alameda County users collected in GovDelivery remain the property of the Alameda County.

User Information

The user information will remain the sole property of the County. GovDelivery, Inc. shall have a license to use the user information in order to provide services for the County. GovDelivery, Inc. never shares information gathered through our government clients with third parties for promotional purposes.

Ownership of Content and GovDelivery

The County maintains sole ownership of all output from the setup services provided under this Service proposal including the database of information associated with e-mail subscriptions.

GovDelivery, Inc. shall maintain sole ownership of GovDelivery and all modifications made to the system and its contents (other than County content) whether these modifications are made specifically to accommodate the County's content within GovDelivery or for another purpose.

Application Security and Connection

GovDelivery, Inc. maintains high security and a robust hosting environment for GovDelivery. Our servers are protected by advanced security firewalls and physical protection. There are 4 redundant connections to the Internet backbone providing exceptional uptime reliability for our clients.

Responsibilities

GovDelivery, Inc. and Alameda County each have specific responsibilities to ensure successful setup and maintenance of GovDelivery.

GovDelivery Responsibilities

GovDelivery, Inc. will provide all of the services outlined in this proposal. There will be one point of contact assigned by GovDelivery, Inc. for the County staff and that person will be responsible for managing GovDelivery. GovDelivery will also provide regular upgrades in technology to the system to stay consistent with the latest browser and mass e-mailing requirements. GovDelivery, Inc. will also provide technical phone/e-mail support during regular business hours for County staff and users.

GovDelivery, Inc. provides online usage reports to quantify the success of the subscription options offered by the County using GovDelivery.

As part of its account management services, GovDelivery, Inc. provides a marketing kit to help the County promote the e-mail subscription services in the local media.

Alameda County Responsibilities

Alameda County will provide:

1. One designated project leader who can coordinate the project with GovDelivery, Inc.
2. Alameda County's best efforts to promote the availability of e-mail subscriptions on its website to its residents through promotions in its offices and through other mediums.

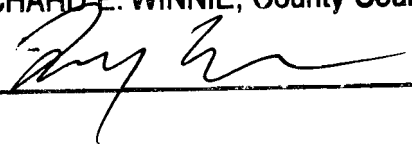
