Subject: Salary Ordinance Amendment

Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

That your Board adopt a Salary Ordinance Amendment (1) establishing three new classes; two in the Sheriff's Office and one in the Department of Child Support Services, and (2) adding three footnotes; one in the Health Care Services Agency; one in the Social Services Agency; and one in the Auditor-Controller Agency.

Discussion/Findings:

We are recommending three new job classes: (8551) Regional Training Center Lead Instructor (SAN) and (8550) Regional Training Center Instructor (SAN) in the Sheriff's Office and (1400) Child Support Training Manager in the Child Support Services Department.

We are also recommending three footnotes: one in the Health Care Services Agency when assigned lead responsibilities when working on the preparation of the annual Health Care Services Agency budget and other special projects; one in the Social Services Agency to extend the footnote for the term of the MOU; and one in the Auditor-Controller Agency when assigned lead responsibility for other Auditor Associate I, II and/or III positions.

Financing:

Funds are available in the 2007-2008 budget appropriation to pay the costs of these actions.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2007-2008
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Section 1-2.2 of Ordinance Number 0-2007-52 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following Job Code Number, Title and Salary effective June 15, 2008:

SECTION II

Article 3 of Ordinance Number 0-2007-52 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following notes.

3-12.72 Not to exceed one employee occupying a position in job code #0229 when assigned lead responsibilities over a comparable job code when working on the preparation of the annual Health Care Services Agency budget and other special projects assigned by the Director, shall receive an additional 5% compensation.

SECTION III

Article 3 of Ordinance Number 0-2007-52 of the Alameda County is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3-18.26 Effective April 14, 2002, not to exceed two persons in the Social Services Agency, Department of Adult and Aging, under Job Code 6770SM when assigned to provide coverage to respond to emergency calls from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., Monday through Friday, and from 5:30 p.m. Friday to 7:30 a.m. Monday, shall receive an additional \$175 per week. This note shall be in full force and effect for the term of the 2006 – 2008 Alameda County Management Employee Association, General Government Unit Memorandum of Understanding.
- 3-3.6 Effective April 6, 2008, not to exceed one person per unit occupying a position under Job Codes 1528 and 1529 shall receive an additional 5 percent compensation above their base salary when assigned lead responsibilities for other Auditor Associate I, II and/or III positions in the Alameda County Auditor-Controller Agency.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.
