**WHEREAS**, forty-two students from throughout Alameda County have been accepted to the California State Summer School for the Arts, the prestigious State arts program, based on their artistic excellence, and are therefore recognized as the State's most outstanding young artists; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Summer School for the Arts enhances the overall cultural community of California by engaging youth in creative studies that encourage critical thinking, collaborative problem solving, and leadership while also encouraging youth to pursue higher education opportunities and contribute to the arts field in California; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Summer School for the Arts accepts 500 students annually selected through a highly competitive process from all over the State. Successful candidates demonstrated excellence in the program areas of Animation, Creative Writing, Film, Dance, Music, Theatre and the Visual Arts; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Summer School for the Arts is a four-week, intensive pre-college program for outstanding, motivated high school students studying the arts to be held this summer on the campus of the California Institute of the Arts in Valencia, CA. Students are accepted into this program solely based on artistic potential, and scholarships are provided to all students who depend on financial support to participate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alameda County Arts Commission is one of thirteen State partners participating in the Arts Scholar Network, a collective of local arts agencies at the county level that are providing essential outreach and recognition support to their regional youth; and
