SUBJECT: ADOPT THE RESOLUTION FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF PATTERSON PASS ROAD FROM FLYNN ROAD WESTWARD TO INTERSECTION OF OLD PATTERSON PASS ROAD IN LIVERMORE ON AUGUST 5, 2024 TO AUGUST 7, 2024 FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC DURING GRINDING AND PAVING OPERATIONS.

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the resolution for the temporary closure of a portion of Patterson Pass Road from Flynn Road westward to intersection of Old Patterson Pass Road in Livermore from August 5, 2024 to August 7, 2024 for the protection of the public during the grinding and paving operations as requested by DeSilva Gates Construction, Inc.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

For the protection of the public during the grinding and paving operations, a portion of Patterson Pass Road needs to be closed. Paragraph (e) of section 21101 of the California Vehicle Code and Section 942.5 of the California Streets and Highways Code allows the Board of Supervisors to close a roadway for the protection of the public.

The duration of the temporary road closure is expected for 2 days on August 5, 2024 to August 7, 2024. DeSilva Gates Construction, Inc. will conduct outreach and contact the affected properties to notify them of the need for the road closure and the expected closure duration.


FINANCING:

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-302

A RESOLUTION FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE
OF A PORTION OF PATTERSON PASS ROAD FROM FLYNN
ROAD WESTWARD TO THE INTERSECTION WITH OLD
PATTERSON PASS ROAD IN LIVERMORE.

WHEREAS, DeSilva Gates Construction, Inc has requested the temporary closure of a portion of Patterson Pass Road from Flynn Road westward to the intersection with Old Patterson Pass Road in unincorporated Livermore, Alameda County, for grinding and paving operations for the County's resurfacing project; and

WHEREAS, the grinding and paving operations require the temporary closure of a portion of Patterson Pass Road for the protection of the public to prevent conflict between the paving equipment and vehicles using the roadway; and

WHEREAS, Paragraph (e) of Section 21101 of the California Vehicle Code allows the Board of Supervisors to close a roadway for the protection of the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 942.5 of the California Streets and Highways Code provides that the Board of Supervisors may close a County highway whenever the Board considers such closing necessary for the protection of the public as well as during construction, improvement or maintenance operations on the highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda does and it hereby authorizes the temporary closure of a portion of Patterson Pass Road from Flynn Road westward to the intersection with Old Patterson Pass Road for the County's resurfacing project in the unincorporated Livermore area, on or around August 5, 2024, with the actual time of the closure to be determined by the Director of Public Works, who is hereby delegated authority under Streets and Highways Code Section 942.6 to implement the closure and make any adjustments to the authorized closure date, time, and location as needed.




