**SUBJECT: FY 2009 CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS GRANT PROJECT**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is respectfully requested that your Honorable Board:

1. Accept grant funds in the amount of \$ 42,142 from the FY 2009 California State Parks Grant Project Agreement Program for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
2. Approve budget adjustments as outlined in the Financial Attachment.

**DISCUSSION/FINDINGS/SUMMARY:**

On June 8, 2009, the Sheriff's Office received a grant award in the amount of \$ 42,142 from the FY 2009 California State Parks Grant Project Program for the performance period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. The award money will be used to purchase five (5) new off-road patrol motorcycles to provide regular and more frequent patrols to much of the eastern half of Alameda County that is mostly rural. This portion of Alameda County stretches eastward over the Altamont Pass into the Central Valley, south into the rugged Mission Peak area, and north toward Mount Diablo.

The Carnegie State Park, a number of East Bay Regional Parks and local park districts within the confines of Alameda County are overwhelmed by the increasing high usage of these park lands which are easily accessible to a large and growing metropolitan area. The Sheriff's Office has supplied mutual aid to supplement California State Police Forces in battling crime, trespassing and unauthorized off-highway motor vehicle operation. The grant will also allow the Sheriff's Office to operate, expand and maintain a law enforcement presence in off-road vehicle recreation areas, roads and trails.
