

## *In Recognition of Steve Cho*

**WHEREAS**, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors is honored to recognize **Steve Cho** for his many years of distinguished service to the citizens of Fremont and Alameda County; and

**WHEREAS**, **Steve Cho** was born and raised in Los Angeles, attended Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri, where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Mathematics, and University of Southern California, where he received his Masters of Science degree in Computer Science; and

**WHEREAS**, **Steve Cho** moved to the Bay Area in 1973 and worked as a Systems Analyst for Pacific Telephone in San Francisco. In 1974, he and his wife, Amy, were married and moved to Fremont; and

**WHEREAS**, ever since moving to Fremont, **Steve Cho** has been active in many community and professional organizations, including being a member of the Board of Directors for the Organization of Chinese Americans; Vice President of Warwick Elementary PTA, Site Council at Thornton Jr. High School; President of Citizens for Better Community; Board Member for APICS-Mission Peak Chapter (Member of the Year, 1984); member of the Fremont City Charter Committee; and member of the Fremont Planning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, it is this community involvement that propelled **Steve Cho** into becoming a Fremont City Councilmember; and

**WHEREAS**, **Steve Cho** is the first Chinese American to be elected to the Fremont City Council where he served from 2000 to 2008, and proved himself to be one of the hardest working, steadfastly dedicated and most visible councilmembers in Fremont history. He is called the “ubiquitous” **Cho** because he is seen everywhere; and

**WHEREAS**, **Steve Cho** is a visionary leader who helped put Fremont on the right path, and citizens of Fremont are forever grateful for his dedicated service to the community.
