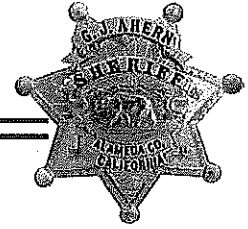

**SUBJECT: APPROVE THE 2014 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM**

Dear Board Members:

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Designate and authorize the Sheriff, by title, to apply for, accept and administer the 2014 State Homeland Security Grant for disaster assistance and overall management of regional emergency response activities, in the amount of \$1,663,024 to the sub-recipients of this award for the performance period beginning 9/1/14 - 5/31/16.
2. Approve and sign the Governing Body Resolution and Resolution of Support for the 2014 Homeland Security Grant.
3. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make the budgetary adjustments as directed in the attached financial recommendation.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The Sheriff's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (OHSES) acts as the lead operational area agency responsible for assisting in the delivery of disaster assistance and the overall management of regional emergency response activities. The continued assistance provided by the State Homeland Security grant will be utilized to build on the progress made toward enhancing the capabilities of law enforcement, emergency medical and management services, public works and public health and their abilities to respond to acts of terrorism involving chemical, biological or nuclear weapons.

The Sheriff's Office will redistribute the **\$1,663,024** award fund as follows:

1. Funding in the amount of **\$83,151** will be allocated to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office to manage and administer the grant which will pay for the salaries and benefits of one Sheriff's Technician.
2. Funding in the amount of **\$300,000** will be provided to the East Bay Regional Communications System Authority (EBRCSA) to purchase equipment and complete the multi-year, regional interoperability communication system project which is a joint project between fire and law enforcement. The installation of dispatch consoles will continue in Alameda County.
3. Funding in the amount of **\$61,703** will be allocated to the Fremont Police Department to purchase Blauer protective suits.
4. Funding in the amount of **\$80,000** will be designated for the purchase of equipment to be used by the Alameda County Bomb Squad to comply with new Homeland Security requirements related to radiological detection and response.
5. Funding in the amount of **\$76,246** will be designated for the Alameda County Fire Department to purchase a handheld chemical identification unit. The unit will be positioned in the Eastern Alameda County, capable of responding to any incident in the Bay Area Region. Funding in the amount of **\$103,613** will purchase a Computer Aided Dispatch system to better coordinate region wide responses to all CBRNE and mass casualty incidents.
6. Funding in the amount of **\$100,000** will be designated for the Alameda County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services to upgrade its airborne mapping system which will improve the ability to map, document and forward natural or terrorist disaster assessment information to first responders throughout the region.
7. Funding in the amount of **\$77,000** will be allocated to Alameda County Emergency Medical Services to provide personal protective equipment to the Tactical Emergency Medical Support teams. This program provides tactical medical support services, enhancing medical and public health preparedness during emergencies and disasters.
8. Funding in the amount of **\$115,786** will be allocated to the Alameda County Public Health Agency to support a newly developed Medical Reserve Corp which is needed to work in coordination with existing local emergency response and to supplement existing community initiatives.
9. Funding in the amount of **\$60,000** will be used by the Alameda County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab to purchase DNA detection equipment for rapid DNA analysis to provide vital information to terrorism investigators in less than two hours.
10. Funding in the amount of **\$200,000** will be allocated to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office to support Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT) with planning, outreach and management of programs and activities for volunteers. This program coordinates volunteer activities to make communities safe and better prepared to respond to any emergency situation. The allocated funds will be redistributed to provide training and supplies to Alameda County cities

and agencies including, but not limited to Alameda, Albany, Berkeley, Fremont, Livermore, Oakland, Pleasanton, Newark, Union City and the Alameda County Fire Departments.

11. Funding in the amount of **\$200,000** will be used by the City of San Leandro PD to purchase a MedEvac Tactical Vehicle.
12. Funding in the amount of **\$21,595** will be used by the Livermore-Pleasanton Fire Dept. to purchase tactical and medical equipment so the Rescue Task Force Teams can provide medical care in a hostile environment resulting from acts of terrorism.
13. Funding in the amount of **\$100,000** will be used by the City Oakland Fire Department to purchase a 50 ft Jet Dock for a 46' Moose Boat (FEMA Type 2 Fire Boat). This Jet Dock provides a safe and stable floating platform and will allow for ease of equipment transfer
14. Funding in the amount of **\$83,930** will be used by the City of Fremont Fire Department to purchase an air automated remote air monitoring system. This equipment will help protect the public by providing vital information for response, protective actions and decontamination

**FINANCING:**

The additional appropriations requested will be fully offset with funding from the 2014 State Homeland security Grant program. This request will not impact the net County costs in FY 2014-2015 or in subsequent years.




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.


