ADOPTION OF COUNTYWIDE AND DEBT SERVICE TAX RATES

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that your Honorable Board of Supervisors adopt the Countywide and Debt Service Tax Rates as shown in the attached Resolution for the 2009-10 fiscal year.

DISCUSSION:

It accordance with Section 93 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, the Board of Supervisors is required to levy a **One Percent** (1%) tax rate on taxable property in Alameda County for the 2009-10 fiscal year. Furthermore, under the various provisions of other code sections the Board is required to levy taxes on taxable property within certain districts of Alameda County to raise sufficient funds to meet the voter-approved indebtedness of these districts.

The Auditor-Controller annually determines the rates necessary to satisfy the debt requirements for these districts.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the attached Resolution as to form.



TAX RATES 2009-10

BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with Section 93 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California this Board does hereby levy a tax rate of 1 percent of full value of taxable property in Alameda County for the fiscal year 2009-10, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, there will accrue interest and the payment of bonds and other voter approved indebtedness for the Community College District and the various Unified School Districts of Alameda County, State of California, and the various other Districts of Alameda County, State of California, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of the laws applicable thereto, it is required that the Board of Supervisors levy a taxable property within the said Districts to raise a sufficient amount of money required for the above mentioned purposes, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California and the various sections of the Education Code of the State of California hereinafter specified, this Board does hereby levy taxable property within each of the following named school districts, within the County, in the amounts hereinafter set forth, to pay the voter approved or other indebtedness requirements of the Districts for the fiscal year 2009-10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2, Part 7, Division 12 (Section 31702) of the Water Code, the Government Code, and the Revenue and Taxation Code, of the State of California, this Board does hereby levy a tax at the rate of .0065 percent of full value of all taxable property within the Alameda County Water District for the purpose of making voter approved indebtedness payments to the State of California Water Project for the fiscal year 2009-10.

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 12 (Subd. 2, Clause [a]) and Section 36 (Subd. 7) of Chapter 55 of the Water Code Appendix (West's California Codes), the Government Code, and the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California, this Board does hereby levy a tax at the rate of .0203 percent of full value of all taxable property within Alameda County Flood Control Zone No. 7 for the purpose of making voter approved indebtedness payments to the State of California Water Project for the fiscal year 2009-10.

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 32312 of the Health and Safety Code, the Government Code, and the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California, this Board does hereby levy a tax at the rate of .0063 percent of full value of all taxable property within Washington Township Health Care District for the purpose of making voter approved indebtedness payments to pay the principal of and interest on the bonded indebtedness of the District for the fiscal year 2009-10.
