

9-1-1 Call Processing



- 9-1-1 Calls must be answered within 15 seconds, 95% of the time (CALOES 9-1-1 Standard)
- Fire responses are dispatched within 64 seconds (National Fire Protection Standard)
- Falck Ambulance is dispatched as soon as a determinant is received (i.e., 9E01)






Annual Call Volume

ACRECC processes over 200,000 Fire / EMS calls per calendar year.






ACRECC Incident Totals C.Y.







Dispatchers work nights, weekends and holidays 3-4, 12 hour shifts with mandatory overtime



Dispatch Layout






