Funds are available in the 2009-2010 budget appropriation to pay the cost resulting from this action.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2009-2010
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Section 1-2.2 of Ordinance Number 0-2008-48 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following Job Code Number, Title and Salary to be effective November 15, 2009.

Article 3 of Ordinance Number 0-2008-48 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the amendment thereto of the following note to be effective November 15, 2009.
