The Alameda County Youth Leadership Academy (YLA) is a free, educational program for high school students in the 11th or 12th grade to learn about local government and complete a career development program alongside their peers from around the County.

Young leaders will have the opportunity to:

- Collaborate with cohort members
- Learn about County programs and services
- Engage with County staff, Department Heads, and Elected Officials
- Build leadership and technical skills to solve community challenges

YLA consists of five Saturday morning sessions (8:30 am—12:00 pm) focusing on County services, including:

- Health Care
- Social Services
- Public Protection and Safety
- County Budget
- Career Development

- September/October 2017 — Program starts
- January/February 2018 — Program ends
