
### **Measure A1 News**



#### Measure A1 Program News

- Rosefield Village in Alameda (City of Alameda Housing Authority) began taking applications to live in this 92-unit mixed income community which provides affordable housing in studios, 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom units to low-income households. Rosefield includes 14 ADA-accessible units. The open application period began on January 17<sup>th</sup> and will close at 5 p.m. on February 7<sup>th</sup>. A1 Funding: \$8,093,414
- Depot Community Apartments in Hayward (Allied Housing, Inc.) broke ground on construction November 15, 2021. This 125-unit project includes 45 homes that are targeted to households with incomes at or below 20% of Area Median Income. A1 Funding: \$5,426,348






# WHY RENEW ALAMEDA COUNTY?

Renew AC enables households to remain safely in the home and not become displaced either due to the home no longer being accessible to them or due to deteriorated conditions.




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
