Measure A1 Program News

- March The Vineyard (Livermore) began construction
 - 23 units for chronically homeless
 - \$6.2M of Measure A1 funding
- April 18 Loro Landing (San Leandro) Grand Opening
 - 57 units
 - \$5.5M of Measure A1 funding
- May Fremont Family project expected to start construction
 - 54 units
 - \$8.5M of Measure A1 funding
- By July 2022 5 A1 projects that received State HCD Housing Accelerator funding expected to start construction
 - Mission Paradise (Hayward), West Grand and Brush (Oakland), Bell Street Gardens (Fremont), 7th & Campbell (Oakland), Ancora Place (Berkeley)
