

The Alameda County Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) seeks a highly motivated and experienced professional to immediately fill the vacant position of Assistant Deputy Director, Community Development Agency with the Homeless Programs Specialty Designation. This Assistant Deputy Director reports to the HCD Director (Deputy Director, CDA) and is a critical component of the management team within HCD. The position oversees HCD's Homeless Division, comprised of ten management, professional, para-professional and clerical staff and administration of Federal, State, and local funding sources. The Division's programs include a wide variety of homeless housing and support programs, including Permanent Supportive Housing, Rapid Rehousing, Emergency Shelter and other interim housing, encampment response, and Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). The Division is also involved in implementing the Homeless Coordinated Entry System in Alameda County and works closely with other County agencies such as the Health Care Services Agency, the Social Services Agency, and the Probation Department, as well as the fourteen cities and numerous community-based organizations.
