- **Compendium Profiles Early Childhood Measures**

The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation and the Administration for Children and Families of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services recently posted *Early Childhood Measures Profiles, 2004* on its Web site. Researchers in Child Trends' Early Childhood Development research unit produced this compendium through the agencies' Science and Ecology of Early Development (SEED) initiative. The compendium includes profiles of early childhood assessments that are commonly used to measure areas of development, including language and literacy, cognition, mathematical understanding, social and emotional competency, and approaches to learning. The profiles include information such as the purposes of the measure, the population it was developed with, the age range intended for, key constructs covered, who administers the measure and the skill level required, what is required of the child during administration and about how long administration takes, the age ranges it is appropriate for, and a summary of reliability and validity data for the measure.
