

TRAUMA CENTER (# 5500)

1. **A Trauma Center is** an acute care hospital designated by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors as such and has:

- 1.1 A written contractual agreement with the County.
- 1.2 Responsibility for the care of major trauma victims.

A major trauma victim as defined by the Title 22, Division 9 means "a person who has sustained acute injury and by means of standardized field triage criteria is judged to be at significant risk of mortality or major morbidity."

2. **Designated Trauma Centers**

- 2.1 Adult Trauma Centers:
 - Highland General Hospital is the designated trauma center for North County
 - Eden Hospital is the designated trauma center for South/East County
- 2.2 Pediatric Trauma Center:
 - Children's Hospital of Oakland.
