COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Dear Resident:

This notification is provided to you as a courtesy from your local Fire Department. Both the San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District and the Alameda County Fire Department wish to inform you that the Camp Parks Fire Department is conducting a controlled vegetation management and training burn beginning Monday August 15th – August 19th. If you smell or see smoke in the Camp Parks Army Reserve Base area located in Dublin, please do not be alarmed. The controlled burn will be conducted between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. each day.

Prescribed vegetation management burns are carefully planned and controlled burns must meet strict criteria of fuel conditions, weather parameters and fire safety guidelines. When all conditions (prescriptions) are met, firefighters will burn while monitoring the set criteria.

Both the San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District and the Alameda County Fire Department will monitor the burn and be on high alert to mitigate any possible risks to the residents of San Ramon and Dublin. We do encourage residents to keep doors and windows closed and small children and pets inside during burn hours.
