**NOTICE OF THE RIGHT TO REQUEST A REVIEW**

Each parent subject to a support order in the State has the right to request that the District Attorney review his/her support order to determine if the amount of support should be changed based on statewide criteria. The District Attorney is not required to review an order if: 1) the order has been reviewed for adjustment within the prior 12 months; or 2) the order has been adjusted within the prior 24 months; or 3) one of the parents cannot be located and there is no new information regarding their whereabouts.

A review may result in an **INCREASE or a DECREASE** in your order depending on the circumstances of both the custodial and non-custodial parent.

**A REQUEST FOR REVIEW MUST BE IN WRITING.**

**ONCE YOU HAVE REQUESTED THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO REVIEW YOUR ORDER, THE REVIEW WILL NOT BE TERMINATED REGARDLESS OF WHETHER YOUR ORDER WILL BE INCREASED OR DECREASED.**
