

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE ALAMEDA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION (LAFCo)
is holding a public hearing to receive protests filed against the following proposal:

**Annexation of the City of Alameda to the Alameda County Emergency Medical Services
(EMS) District**

(County Service Area EM-1983-1)

**Monday, June 20, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, Council Chambers, 3rd Floor,
2263 Santa Clara Avenue, Alameda, California**

The City of Alameda initiated the annexation proposal via resolution of application for the purpose of maintaining essential emergency paramedic and trauma care services. The subject annexation area includes the entire City of Alameda. The annexed territory shall be subject to the levying or fixing and collection of the previously authorized EMS special tax. All other terms and conditions are outlined in Alameda LAFCo Resolution No. 2011-06 which is available upon request through the LAFCo office.

How to File a Protest: Any **registered voter or owner of land within the subject annexation territory** may file a written protest against the proposal with the Alameda LAFCo Executive Officer at any time prior to the conclusion of the protest hearing on this proposal. Protests may either be delivered to Alameda LAFCo at 1221 Oak Street, Room 555, Oakland, CA 94612 or to the LAFCo Executive Officer at the protest hearing. Each written protest must be signed and dated, must state whether it is made by a landowner or a registered voter, and must include the name and address of the protestor and a street or parcel number identifying the location of the land. Only valid, written protests will be used to determine the value of protests filed and not withdrawn.
