

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ALAMEDA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Alameda Local Agency Formation Commission will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 4:30 p.m.** at the Dublin San Ramon Services District Board Room at 7051 Dublin Boulevard, Dublin, California.

At the hearing, the Commission will discuss the following items:

- **Creekside Landing - USD Annexation U-290** – The Commission will consider an application by the property owner to annex approximately 58± acres to Union Sanitary District to provide sanitary sewer service for proposed construction of three new warehouses. The property, generally located northwest of the intersection of I-880 & Dixon Landing Road in Fremont, is bounded by Channel ‘B’ to the north, the future Fremont Blvd. extension to the west, I-880 to the east, and Dixon Landing Rd. to the south.
- **Reorganization of the Curbside Recycling CSA** – The Commission will consider a proposal by the County of Alameda to dissolve the Curbside Recycling County Service Area (CSA) and annex the same area (approximately 1,174 acres) into the Oro Loma Sanitary District (OLSD) for the purpose of providing refuse collection and recycling services only with no change in level of service. The current contracted service provider, Waste Management of Alameda County, will continue to provide the same solid waste and recycling collection services through OLSD’s franchise agreement with the company.
- **Proposed Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Budget and Work Plan** – Review and consider the proposed budget and work plan for Fiscal Year 2014-2015.

At the meeting, the Commission will consider all oral and written testimony of any interested persons or affected agencies. Only those issues which are brought up at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to LAFCo at or prior to the hearing may be raised in any legal challenge to the actions taken by the Commission with respect to an application.

Copies of the Commission agenda, staff reports and supporting information will be available and may be examined at the LAFCo office, located in the Alameda County Administration Building, 1221 Oak Street, Suite 555, Oakland, CA, at least five days prior to the meeting date.
