

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ALAMEDA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Alameda Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, May 12, 2011 at 4:30 p.m.** at the Dublin San Ramon Services District Board Room at 7051 Dublin Boulevard, Dublin, California.

At the hearing, the Commission will discuss the following items:

- **Annexation of City of Alameda into Alameda County Emergency Medical Services District** – Proposed annexation of the City of Alameda into the Alameda County Emergency Medical Services District (County Service Area EM-1983-1) in order to maintain essential emergency paramedic and trauma care services.
- **Southeast Area National Labs Reorganization** – Proposed reorganization to annex approximately 1,025 acres to the City of Livermore to bring the national laboratories within city limits, align the existing urban growth boundary, and facilitate the development of the Innovation for Green Advanced Transportation Excellence (I-GATE) innovation hub. The proposal includes the concurrent detachment of the subject property from the Alameda County Library District and the Alameda County Fire Department. The subject area is generally located southeast of the current city boundary, more specifically south of Patterson Pass Road, east of South Vasco Road, west of Greenville Road, and north of Tesla Road.
- **Fiscal Year 2011-12 Final Budget and Work Plan** – On March 10, 2011, the Commission approved the Proposed Fiscal Year 2011-12 Budget and Work Plan. This is a presentation and public hearing on the final budget and work plan for Fiscal Year 2011-12.

At the meeting, the Commission will consider all oral and written testimony of any interested persons or affected agencies. Only those issues which are brought up at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to LAFCo at or prior to the hearing may be raised in any legal challenge to the actions taken by the Commission with respect to an application.

Copies of the Commission agenda, staff reports and supporting information will be available and may be examined at the LAFCo office, located in the Alameda County Administration Building, 1221 Oak Street, Suite 555, Oakland, CA, at least five days prior to the meeting date.
