At the hearing, the Commission will discuss the following items:

- Las Positas Road Reorganization No. 5 (also referred to as Hilliker); Annexation to the City of Livermore and Detachment from the Alameda County Library District and the Alameda County Fire Department The City of Livermore proposes to annex 45± acres and detach the same territory from the Alameda County Library District (ACLD) and Alameda County Fire Department (ACFD), with corresponding amendments to the ACLD and the ACFD Spheres of Influence, for the purpose of eliminating an unincorporated island within the City limits, and to maintain and support the existing rural character of the subject site. The property consists of 14 parcels (various Assessor Parcel Numbers) and is located adjacent to and south of Las Positas Road, east of North Livermore Ave. This item is continued from the May 2009 meeting.
- City of Hayward Out-of-Area Service Agreement Arbutus Court The City of Hayward proposes to provide sewer services to two parcels (425-0500-029 and 425-0500-030) located on Arbutus Court in the southern section of the Fairview District of unincorporated Alameda County.
- Consideration of Proposed Revised Fee Schedule The Commission will consider proposed changes to its adopted fee schedule and related policies, including establishing hourly staff rates.

At the meeting, the Commission will consider all oral and written testimony of any interested persons or affected agencies. Only those issues which are brought up at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to LAFCo at or prior to the hearing may be raised in any legal challenge to the actions taken by the Commission with respect to an application.
