The Associated Community Action Program (ACAP) announces the availability of \$325,000.00 in Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds for the calendar year January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012. Eligible applicants are non-profit and public agencies that provide services and are located within the ACAP service area (Alameda County not including Oakland and Berkeley, which administrate their own CSBG funding pools). ACAP has identified its funding priority as Jobs/Housing Case management for Family Self-Sufficiency and solicits proposals from community-based agencies to provide services to low-income individuals and families. Those eligible to receive services are those who receive cash public assistance, are homeless, or meet the following income levels:
