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HIGH STREET BRIDGE REOPENS EARLY

ALAMEDA COUNTY – The Alameda County Public Works Agency has completed the Phase 1 rehabilitation and bridge deck repair work on High Street Bridge, between the cities of Oakland and Alameda. The High Street Bridge is open to traffic.

Phase 2 and Phase 3 of the High Street and Park Street Rehabilitation Project will begin Monday, May 11, 2015. During this phase of construction, the Park Street Bridge will be CLOSED to vehicle traffic, bicyclists, and pedestrians between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. from May 11, 2015 through August 14, 2015. There will also be some limitations to marine traffic. The US Coast Guard will communicate this information in its weekly "Coast Guard Local Notices to Mariners."

Detour signs will be in place to guide motorists around the closure area. When traveling through the construction and detour areas, motorists are advised to exercise caution and adhere to all traffic regulations.

This schedule is subject to change. Additional information will be provided for subsequent phases.
