



## 2020 Alameda County Citizens Academy and Youth Leadership Academy Postponed due to COVID-19

Due to the Alameda County Health Officer's shelter in place order, we are postponing the 2020 Alameda County Citizens Academy (ACCA) and Youth Leadership Academy (YLA) and will reassess the feasibility of conducting the programs in the spring.

The ACCA and YLA were founded to provide a forum for the community to learn and become engaged with Alameda County government. Historically, the Academy provides tours of several County facilities, demonstrations of specialized equipment, and hands-on activities designed to illustrate the impact of County services on our communities. The academies have grown year after year, and we fully intend to safely continue the programs moving forward.
