APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR ALAMEDA COUNTY TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR
Board of Supervisors to Appoint Successor to Donald White, Who Retired

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors is accepting applications from people interested in becoming the County's next Treasurer-Tax Collector, following the retirement last week of longtime Treasurer-Tax Collector Donald White.

White retired before completing his sixth elected term in office and the Board of Supervisors will appoint a successor to serve the remainder of his current term. The position is up for election again in 2018.

People interested in applying should obtain an application packet from the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. The clerk's office is located in Suite 536 of the Alameda County Administration Building, 1221 Oak Street, Oakland. The Clerk's office is open from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Application packets can be obtained in person only.

The deadline to apply for the position is 5 p.m. on FRIDAY, MARCH 24, 2017. Applications must be filed in person by the applicant, or the applicant's representative, with the Clerk of the Board of the Board of Supervisors.
