Alameda – Oakland Estuary Bridges Temporary Closure Schedule

The Alameda County Public Works Agency will be closing traffic lanes on the Miller-Sweeney Bridge, Park Street Bridge and High Street Bridge on different days beginning in April. The closures are necessary for engineering teams to perform bridge inspections. The lane closures will be during non-peak hours and at night. Detour signs will be posted. Motorists are advised to please use caution when driving through the area. The schedule of the closures is as follows:

Miller-Sweeney Bridge (connects with Fruitvale Avenue):

- **On Monday, April 2**, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., there will be lane closures. At least one lane will be open with restricted access and traffic control measures in place. Motorists should expect delays.
- **On Tuesday, April 3**, lanes will be closed during the day, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Then, later that night, from 9:00 p.m. – 1:00 a.m., all lanes will be closed. There will be no vehicle access. Motorists should follow the posted detour or choose another way to enter or exit Alameda.

High Street Bridge:

- **From Wednesday, April 4 through Friday, April 6**, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day, all lanes will be closed. There will be no vehicle access. Motorists should follow the posted detour or choose another way to enter or exit Alameda.

Park Street Bridge:

- **From Monday, April 9 through Thursday, April 12**, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day, there will be lane closures. Motorists may only have access to one lane of traffic. On Wednesday night, April 11, all lanes will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. There will be no vehicle access. Motorists should follow the posted detour or choose another way to enter or exit Alameda.

The inspection work is part of the continued maintenance for the three drawbridges. Detour signs, roadside advisories and changeable message signs will alert motorist ahead of time to the scheduled work.
