**CONSTRUCTION SET TO BEGIN  
ON KILKARE ROAD**

SUNOL, CA – The Alameda County Public Works Agency will begin construction activities on the Kilkare Road/Main Street intersection realignment project on Monday, October 10, 2016. During construction, the off ramp to the intersection will be closed from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Realignment of the intersection is expected to take 45 workdays to complete. The schedule is subject to change, and efforts will be made to complete the project by the end of 2016.

Detour signs will be in place, and motorists should expect delays. During hauling and excavation operations, the road may be closed and public traffic stopped for periods of no longer than 10 minutes. After each closure, accumulated traffic will be allowed to pass through the work area before another closure is made. When approaching the work zone, motorists are encouraged to reduce their speed, observe the construction signs, and use caution around personnel and equipment.
