



Golden State Warriors and Alameda County Team Up to Get Out the Vote

Alameda County Residents Will Have a New Option When Looking for a Place to Cast a Vote on Election Day

Oakland, Ca—Today the Golden State Warriors and the County of Alameda are honored to announce a unique partnership that will provide a safe and accessible voting location in downtown Oakland. The Warriors, in collaboration with the County of Alameda will open the doors of the team's Oakland Facility at 1011 Broadway for the November 3, 2020 General Election.

The use of the Warriors' Oakland Facility as an accessible voting location ensures that social distancing measures are put in place and that County health guidelines are followed. Alameda County residents can vote and/or drop off their ballots safely prior to and on Election Day.

“Never has it been more important to provide the public with safe and convenient locations to cast a vote or drop off a ballot,” says Alameda County Board of Supervisors President Richard Valle. “The County is grateful to the Warriors organization for its support of and commitment to ensuring an accessible and secure election for all of our residents and diverse communities.”

The Warriors' Oakland Facility, home to Generation Thrive and Warriors Basketball Academy, will activate as a polling site and ballot drop-off beginning on Saturday, October 31.

Hours for the Warriors' Oakland Facility polling site and ballot drop-off:

- Saturday, October 31: 9:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.
- Sunday, November 1: 9:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 2: 9:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.
- Tuesday, November 3 (Election Day): 7:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m.

The Warriors' Oakland Facility will be staffed by Alameda County election workers. Applications are still being accepted to serve as an election worker in Alameda County. The Warriors' Oakland Facility is located at 1011 Broadway in downtown Oakland. It is easily accessed by the 12th St. BART stop and AC Transit. There is also ample street parking as well as parking lots close to the facility.
