**PUBLIC INPUT SOUGHT ON
BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN UPDATE
FOR UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF ALAMEDA COUNTY**

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – The Alameda County Public Works Agency is currently updating its Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan for Unincorporated Areas. The Plan will develop strategies to improve bicycle and pedestrian safety; increase access to work, school, shopping, recreation, and transit; and facilitate more walking and biking in the Alameda County Unincorporated Areas.
