NOMINATIONS DEADLINE EXTENDED FOR 25th ANNUAL ALAMEDA COUNTY WOMEN'S HALL OF FAME

The deadline has been extended to **Wednesday, January 31**, to nominate outstanding local women to the Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame, which is celebrating its 25th year of honoring extraordinary women making a difference in the community.

Honorees will be celebrated at the 25th Annual Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame Luncheon and Awards Ceremony on Saturday, March 24, 2018, at the Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Oakland. Once again, this inspiring event will be co-hosted by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors and the Alameda County Commission on the Status of Women.

For its 25th Anniversary, the Women's Hall of Fame is accepting nominations in a new category: **Emerging Leader**, which will celebrate young women representing a new generation of leaders. In addition, women will be honored in 12 other categories: Business and Professions; Community Service; Culture and Art; Education; Environment; Health; Justice; Non-Traditional Careers; Science, Technology, Engineering; Sports and Athletics; Philanthropy and Youth.

More than 200 women have been inducted into the Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame since the program started in 1993. In addition to honoring extraordinary women leaders from Alameda County, the annual event raises funds to provide youth scholarships and supports local nonprofit community partners serving women, youth and families.
