**PALOMARES ROAD AND
UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY
ROAD CLOSURE UPDATE**

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – Alameda County Public Works Agency crews continue emergency repair efforts to address sinkholes, culvert failures, slope stabilization and clean-up of roadway issues at several locations along Palomares Road.

Palomares Road remains **CLOSED** to all thru traffic between Palo Verde Road, Castro Valley, and Niles Canyon Road (Highway 84), Fremont. Motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians are advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes. The Public Works Agency anticipates reopening the road next week, with one-lane traffic controls in some locations on Palomares Road. This is subject to change should additional safety concerns arise.

Current status of other County-maintained roads is as follows:

- **Redwood Road, Castro Valley**, is reduced to one lane of traffic at mile marker 7.38 due to a shoulder washout. Safety devices and traffic control measures are in place.
- **Koopman Road, Sunol**, is reduced to one lane of traffic at mile marker 0.23 following a mudslide. Safety devices and traffic control measures are in place.
- **Foothill Road, Sunol**, is reduced to one lane of traffic at mile marker 6.87 following storm-related damage to the roadway. Safety devices and traffic control measures are in place.
- **Collier Canyon Road, Livermore**, is reduced to one lane of traffic at mile marker 4.98 due to a shoulder slip-out. Safety devices and traffic control measures are in place.

Please avoid these areas, if possible. If you must travel on any of these roadways, please proceed with caution.

All other roadways in unincorporated Alameda County remain open at this time.
