HELICOPTER TO PLACE EQUIPMENT FOR PALOMARES ROAD CLEAN UP

CASTRO VALLEY, CA – The Alameda County Public Works Agency is continuing its debris clean-up and slope stabilization efforts in the vicinity of mile marker 8.70.

Our contractor and geologist have inspected the area and developed the scope of work to safely secure these hazardous rocks. Loose rocks will be removed, and a mesh netting system will be installed to stabilize the hillside.

A helicopter will be used to place construction equipment on the hillside on Friday, June 2, 2017. The flight path will not be over any residential homes or businesses along Palomares Road.

Palomares Road remains closed to thru traffic between Palo Verde Road, Castro Valley, and Niles Canyon Road, Fremont. Residents will need to access their homes from either Palo Verde Road or Niles Canyon Road.

Motorists, cyclists and pedestrians are advised to avoid the areas, and use alternate routes.
