**ROAD CLOSURE UPDATES FOR
UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY**

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – Following are the updated road conditions as of Monday, January 23, 2017, 10:00 a.m.:

- Palomares Road is closed between Palo Verde Road, Castro Valley, and Niles Canyon Road (Highway 84), Fremont, due to several mudslides. Motorists are advised to avoid the areas and use alternate routes.
- Tesla Road, Livermore, remains closed between Cross Road, Livermore, and Corral Hollow Road, Tracy, due to localized flooding in San Joaquin County. Please see the San Joaquin County (<https://www.sjgov.org/residents/road-closures>)
- Mines Road, Livermore, is open. Alameda County Public Works Agency crews are on scene removing mudslide debris approximately 12 miles south of intersection of Mines Road and Del Valle Road, Livermore. Traffic control is in place to direct motorists around mudslide area. Motorists should proceed with caution in the mudslide area and around road work personnel.
- Kilcare Road, Sunol, is open. Alameda County Public Works Agency crews are on scene removing mudslide debris. Traffic control is in place to direct motorists around mudslide area. Motorists should proceed with caution in the mudslide area and around road work personnel.
- Old Altamont Pass Road, Livermore, is open. Precautionary signs are in place to advise motorists that there is potential flooding in this area. Motorists should proceed with caution.
