UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY ROAD CLOSURES

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – Alameda County Public Works Agency crews have addressed storm-related mudslides, downed trees and localized flooding on unincorporated Alameda County roadways.

Current status of County-maintained roads (as of 3:45 p.m.) is as follows:

- Palomares Road will remain CLOSED to all traffic, between Palo Verde Road, Castro Valley, and Niles Canyon Road (Highway 84), Fremont, until further notice. Crews will continue to remove mudslide debris from the roadway throughout the night.
- Kilkare Road, Sunol, has reopened to all traffic.
- Crow Canyon Road, Castro Valley, has reopened to all traffic.
- Norris Canyon Road, Castro Valley, has reopened to all traffic.
- Foothill Road, Pleasanton, is currently open.
- Proceed with caution on these roadways as localized flooding has been reported:
 - May School Road, Livermore
 - Dagnino Road and Raymond Road, Livermore

All other County-maintained roads are currently open.
