**Traffic Delays During
Ribbon Cutting Celebration**

SAN LEANDRO, CA – On Saturday, April 13th, the Public Works Agency will be celebrating the completion of the Stanley Boulevard Improvement Project with a community fair and ribbon cutting ceremony.

During this celebration, the eastbound lanes of Stanley Boulevard will be closed between Shadow Cliffs Recreational Park and Cemex Quarries for the ribbon cutting and ceremonial bike ride between 9:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Shadow Cliffs Recreational Area will remain open and accessible to the public. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction on the westbound lanes of Stanley Boulevard. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes, if possible for other destinations. If travelling through the ceremony area, motorists are urged to exercise caution and adhere to all traffic regulations.

The public is invited to join the celebration and attend a community fair featuring the tri-valley bike lane/trail networks, safety information, and personal sustainability practices will begin at 10:00 a.m. at Shadow Cliffs recreational area. Lunch will be provided following the ribbon cutting festivities.
