UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY ROAD CLOSURES

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – Current status of County-maintained roads (as of 5:00 p.m.) is as follows:

- Palomares Road remains CLOSED to all thru traffic between Palo Verde Road, Castro Valley, and Niles Canyon Road (Highway 84), Fremont, due to a major mudslide at mile marker 8.73. The roadway is impassable between mile marker 8.6 and mile marker 8.8. Residents may access their homes from either Palo Verde Road or Niles Canyon Road. All other motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians are advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes.
- Tesla Road is CLOSED at Cross Road, Livermore, until further notice due to flooding on Tesla Road in San Joaquin County. Please use alternate routes.
- Welch Creek Road, Livermore, is CLOSED due to downed trees and mudslides. ACPWA anticipates reopening of the roadway later tonight.

Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) crews are responding to the following storm-related incidents on unincorporated roadways:

- Norris Canyon Road, Castro Valley – mudslide removal on westbound lane
- Crow Canyon Road, Castro Valley – mudslide removal in the vicinity of 9338 Crow Canyon Road;
- Altamont Pass Road, Livermore – localized flooding at mile marker 0.93; and
- Foothill Road, Pleasanton – localized flooding in the vicinity of Verona Avenue.

Motorists are encouraged to avoid all areas above.
