TIM DUPUIS APPOINTED INTERIM DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND REGISTRAR OF VOTERS

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors on Tuesday announced the unanimous appointment of Tim Dupuis as the Interim Director of Information Technology and Registrar of Voters effective December 17, 2012.

Dupuis replaces Dave Macdonald, who is retiring. Macdonald has been the County's Director of Information Technology since 1985 and assumed the joint role of Registrar of Voters in 2006.

Dupuis has been Alameda County's Chief Technology Officer since 2000 and in that role he has worked closely with Macdonald while being responsible for all day-to-day operations of the Information Technology Department.

Dupuis is credited with developing the County's first iPhone/iPad and Android applications and for establishing a smart phone-friendly web portal on Alameda County's award-winning website, acgov.org.

He also worked closely with Macdonald on two key projects for the Registrar of Voters: automating the Registrar's Roster Index process, which reduced processing time from two weeks to two days; and developing a Chain of Custody application to track all equipment moving between the Registrar's Office and the many polling places set up around the County during elections. Both projects won awards from the National Association of Counties.

Nate Miley, President of the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, said, "By working as both Information Technology director and Registrar of Voters, Dave Macdonald has helped Alameda County keep a leg up in staying on top of the many new technologies that are being created to make our elections operate more efficiently. While we hate to lose him, there is nobody better suited to take over for Dave than Tim Dupuis, who has worked so closely with him for many years."

Susan S. Muranishi, County Administrator, added, "We will miss the outstanding leadership Dave Macdonald has provided in these important roles and on other countywide initiatives. We also know that Dave leaves Alameda County in a strong position by helping to develop new leaders like Tim Dupuis."
