CLOSE OF REGISTRATION FOR MARCH 5, 2013 PIEDMONT USD SPECIAL ELECTION

The **deadline to register to vote** for the March 5, 2013 Piedmont USD Special Election is **Monday, February 18, 2013**.

Alameda County residents must be citizens, 18 years old and not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony to be eligible to register to vote.

Voter registration affidavits are available at the Registrar of Voter's office, libraries, fire stations and post offices. You can also apply to register to vote right now by filling in the online application through California Secretary of State's website at www.registertovote.ca.gov.

Completed affidavits must be delivered to the Registrar of Voter's office at 1225 Fallon Street, Room G-1, Oakland, CA 94612 **or postmarked by February 18th** in order to be valid for this election.
