NOMINATION DEADLINE EXTENDED TO DECEMBER 6 FOR 21ST ANNUAL ALAMEDA COUNTY WOMEN'S HALL OF FAME

The Nomination Deadline has been extended to December 6 for the 21st Annual Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame, which next March will honor outstanding women in the community for a wide range of vital contributions.

The 21st Annual Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame luncheon and awards ceremony will be held Saturday, March 29, 2014, at the Greek Orthodox Cathedral on Lincoln Avenue in Oakland. The event will be hosted by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors and the Alameda County Commission on the Status of Women.

Nominations are being accepted for outstanding women in 12 categories: Business and Professions; Community Service; Culture and Art; Education; Environment; Health; Justice; Non-Traditional Careers; Science, Technology, Engineering; Sports and Athletics; Philanthropy and Youth.

The program raises money for local charities addressing issues affecting women and children. In 2014, the Women's Hall of Fame will also continue its commitment to youth by sponsoring a Youth Scholarship to help an 11th or 12th grade female student further her education.
