EARLY VOTING & VOTE-BY-MAIL PERIOD FOR
NOVEMBER 4, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION

Early Voting for the November 4, 2014 General Election will be available at the Registrar of Voters' Office starting on Monday, October 6, 2014. Office hours are 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.

The Vote-By-Mail period for this election is from Monday, October 6th through Tuesday, October 28th.

Voters may request a Vote-By-Mail Ballot at any time from now until October 28th for the November 4, 2014 General Election by one of the following ways: completing the application on the back of their sample ballot, sending an email, send a written request via fax at (510) 272-6982, by mail, or call the Registrar of Voters at (510) 272-6973 to request for a ballot to be mailed to you. Voters may also complete the online Vote-By-Mail application at www.acgov.org/rov/votbymail.htm.

Only the registered voter himself or herself may apply for a vote by mail ballot. An application for a vote by mail ballot that is made by any person other than the registered voter is a criminal offence.

The Registrar of Voters must receive all written requests for Vote-By-Mail Ballots no later than October 28th at 5:00 P.M. Voted ballots must be returned to the Registrar of Voters or any polling place within Alameda County no later than the close of polls on Election Day. Postmarks are not accepted.
